Assignment to Administer

the Attachment of Debtor's Monetary Claims on behalf of Enforcement Officer

To sustain the performance of the enforcement officer in the attachment of debtor's monetary claims to be expeditious and efficient, by virtue of Section 32 of State Administration Act B.E. 2534 (1991) amended by State Administration Act (No.5) B.E. 2545 (2002), Section 6, 7, and 8 of Royal Decree on Authorization B.E. 2550 (2007), and in accordance with Section 1(14) of the Civil Procedure Code, the Legal Execution Department hereby order as follows;

1. The Director of Legal Execution Office in capacity of enforcement officer shall assign the general administration officer to administer the attachment of debtor's monetary claims under his or her supervision and suggestion.

2. The general administration officer shall comply with the attachment of debtor's monetary claims manual.

3. In case the attachment of debtor's monetary claims contain sophisticated issues, the Director of Legal Execution Office shall assign such cases to the enforcement officer. In case where the court issue summons, the Director of Legal Execution Office may, upon discretion, assign the enforcement officer to appear before the court with the general administration officer.

4. The general administration officer's performance in the period of 3 months from 3rd April B.E. 2560 (2017) shall be under supervision of the enforcement officer.

5. The attachment of debtor's monetary claims that have been administered before 3rd April B.E. 2560 (2017), the enforcement officer holding the cases shall proceed to completion.

This order shall be in effect since 3rd April B.E. 2560 (2017).
